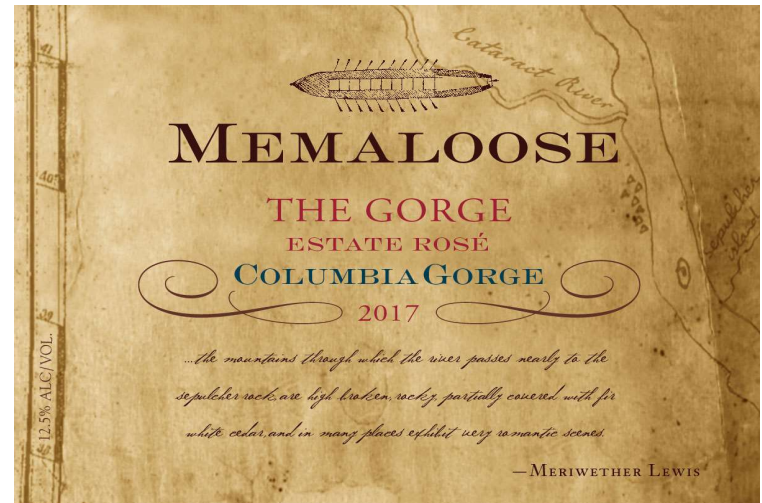


Wine Composition

- Variete:** Syrah (42%) Grenache (58%)
- Origins:** Idiots' Grace Vineyard, Mosier, OR, USA (Syrah)
Mistral Ranch, Lyle, WA USA (Grenache)
- Growers:** Robert & Brian McCormick
- The Sites:** Syrah grown in old dune sand east of Mosier. Certified organic. Grenache plucked from a basalt shelf west of Lyle some 600 feet upslope of the Columbia River
- The Vintage:** 2017 seemed to mark a return to balance. Or at least in the direction thereof. Quite distinct from the flirtation with extremes in 2015 & 2016.
- A Few Words:** Is this a white wine that wants to be red, or the other way 'round?

Fermentation, Upbringing and Bottling

- Crushed and immediately pressed.
- Fermented without added yeast or bacteria, in stainless steel and older barrels.
- Malolactic conversion complete.
- 120 cases produced
